

Theme is a very important aspect of Easter Venture and, besides having its own trophy, Theme points contribute one quarter to your team's overall EV score. So, without further ado:

How to **WIN** the **THEME TROPHY** at EV:



Step 1: Before EV

Theme Your Team

- Brainstorm the EV theme
 - Think outside the box if you want
- Pick an idea
 - Costume ideas
 - Prop ideas
 - Create an IDENTITY
- Dress in theme, bring props in theme
- (But remember you will have to carry everything – so be clever!)

Step 2: During EV

Activities, Hiking & Camping, Partying...

- **Everything** you do in theme at EV will earn you theme points
- More in-theme you behave, the more points you may earn
- Objective: impress EV Theme Team with your team's themed behaviour

General Advice

- Relax into the theme, have fun with it
- EV Theme Team enjoy working with teams who are into the theme – these teams tend to earn more theme points.
- Any leader can give you EV Money – so convince them why you deserve it.
- Always cash in your EV money at the Bank so that you can earn more later

Earning Theme Points

- Complete as many lunch and night time activities as possible
 - Do these in theme for extra points
- Earn as much EV Money as possible
 - Complete challenges set by Theme Team
 - Complete activities (both during the hike and at lunch & night locations)
 - Demonstrate how awesome your theme is to Theme Team
- Collect a complete set of trading cards
 - You will need to barter with other teams.
